1. ARE YOU READY TO GO?

Please double-check that you have **all necessary documents** at hand, which are

- your **e-ticket** or **flight confirmation**
- your **passport** and all **visa documents**
- your **travel insurance document** (available on www.symposium.org/importantdocuments)
- name and **address of your host**
- the symposium's **contact details**

- make sure to **contact your host** in advance
- let us and your host know about any changes regarding your time of arrival
- show up at the airport/train station on time
- take clothes with you that fit the **dresscode**:
 - Tuesday (Touristic Day): casual, suitable clothes for outside (warm and rainproof, comfortable shoes)
 - Wednesday: business casual (for men no tie) or, if preferred, traditional robe
 - Thursday and Friday: business attire or, if preferred, traditional robe
- don't forget to **signpost your luggage** inside and outside, with your name and the symposium's contact details.

If your luggage gets lost, it is important to communicate the above-mentioned address to the people concerned with lost luggage at the airport or train station.

2. YOUR ARRIVAL IN ST. GALLEN

As soon as you arrive at **Zurich Airport**, please proceed to the **St. Gallen Symposium Convention Desk at Arrival 1** which is the general meeting point for all participants at the airport. From there, we will take you directly to your host who is awaiting you in St. Gallen. The **badge** you receive at the airport will not only serve you as your **free ticket for public transport** in the city of St. Gallen* but is also your entrance ticket to the symposium. It is very important for you **not to lose this badge**.
